In October 2016, I am still working on the SABVC Connects Program. Besides the Marketing and promoting actions, the focuses now are:

- 1) ACMHI Project: An upcoming plan after some adjusts in the original plan. The updated plan was already approved by ASEC, Alberta Students' Executive Council.
- 2) #IBelieveYou Campaign: I started this campaign on campus in October. My plan is to create new actions to increase awareness, prevent it and support victims. The SABVC Mental Health Committee will help me with this project.
